The Junior America's Cup (JAC) first started in 1973 at Pebble Beach, California. The team competition annually brings together an elite international field of up to 18 teams representing 12 western states, 2 Canadian provinces and Mexico. The 54-Hole tournament counts the best 3 scores of 4, daily, concluding with a formal Awards ceremony where Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are presented.

Format

Stroke play for the team only. The Sally Pini Medalist Trophy is also awarded annually.

Qualifiers

1. April 29-30 at Henderson Lake
2. May 20-21 at RedTail Landing Golf Club
3. June 10-11 at Coal Creek

**If one of the tournaments listed above is cancelled, the Big Chief Alberta Junior on June 17-18 at Inglewood will be the final qualifier.*

Requirements

Juniors who wish to qualify for CJGA Team Alberta must meet the following requirements:

- Juniors must play in a minimum of 2 qualifiers for the international competition
- In order to be eligible for qualifying, juniors must meet the age requirement for the international event.
- Juniors must be a full member and in good standing with the Canadian Junior Golf Association
- Juniors who are selected to represent Alberta must be either a Canadian citizen or hold a permanent resident card.

Selection Process

The CJGA Selection Committee will determine the juniors who represent CJGA Team Alberta by the following process:

1. Players will be selected by a JAC Alberta Order of Merit.
2. For each designated qualifier, the results for the Juvenile and Junior divisions will be merge into one field for the tournament. Points will then be awarded based on a player's finish in that field using the CJGA National Order of Merit - Tier 3 point structure. See chart below.
3. The top 2 point finishes from a player's results will then be totaled.
4. The leading 2 boys from the JAC Alberta Order of Merit will be selected to represent CJGA Team Alberta
5. Ties in the selection process will be decided by Section B of the CJGA Conditions of the Competition.

**Note: The CJGA reserves the right to select team members outside of qualifying requirements*
